# SUPERVISION



- Lieutenant in charge of each Division
- Each shift has a minimum of a Corporal in charge of the shift
- The shift supervisor is responsible for call prioritization and assignments during their shift

# Patrol Division



- Squads will consist of 5 officers and a supervisor
- MINE HILL- WILL HAVE OWN DEDICATED PATROL ZONE
- Larger patrol squads give the ability to handle multiple situations while still providing coverage. DWI Arrest, Domestic Violence, Major Accidents
- 24 Officers assigned to Patrol Division

# Detective Division

- Staffed by 5 full time Detectives and a Supervisor
- Normal working hours M-F 7a-10p .
- On call Detective to handle serious crimes and evidence collection 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.



# Traffic Division



- Staffed with 5 Officers and a Supervisor
- Patrol during high volume traffic times which are between hours of 6a-2a
- Develop and review all major event plans and coordinate all traffic patterns and detours
