GARBAGE and **ONE BULK ITEM** per Household will continue to be picked up **Every Thursday**

- *Place Garbage to the Curb by 6:30 AM (or the night before)
- *Garbage Cans **MUST** be standard 32 gallon containers weighing less than 50 lbs.

Mine Hill Township Vegetative Waste Schedule for 2013

VEGETATIVE WASTE will continue to be picked up **Every OTHER Tuesday**
Beginning March 26 and **Ending December 3**

- *Place Vegetative Waste to the Curb by 6:30 AM (or the night before)
- *Branches and Brush **MUST** be cut to 4' (four foot) lengths and bundled with twine
- *Grass Clippings and Leaves **MUST** either be bagged in Brown Yard Waste Bags or placed in a **CLEARLY MARKED** 32 gallon container weighing less than 50 lbs. Yard Waste Bags are available for purchase at Town Hall (10 bags for \$5).

Phone Books and Paperback Books
Plastic Containers Labeled #1, #2, #4, #5, #7
Glass Bottles and Jars
Metal Cans, Metal Jar Lids
Aluminum Foil, Pie Plates and Trays

NOT ACCEPTED:
