**SPECIFICATIONS FOR DOLORES STREET ASPHALT PATH REPAIR PROJECT**

This Addendum is issued to prospective bidders for Contract Documents already published. Changes contained herein will be taken into account in submitting any bid for this Work. **The Bidder is required to acknowledge receipt of these changes** to the Contract Documents in the “Acknowledgement of Receipt of Changes to Bid Documents Form found in the Proposal and on the “Bid Document Submission Checklist”

1. **INTERPRETATION OF CONTRACT DOCUMENTS** on pages IB-11 and IB-12 shall read as follows: *No oral interpretations of the meaning of the contract documents or as to anything to be done by the successful contractor or as to any other matter will be made to any bidder. Every request for an interpretation shall be in writing, addressed to Gary Gartenberg, P.O.Box 243, Convent Station N.J. Phone 973-998-0411. The last date for the bidders to submit written Requests for Information will be Tuesday, October 22, 2013. Any and all such interpretations and any supplemental instructions shall be in the form of written addenda to the specifications. Such addenda shall be on file in the Township Offices. Furthermore, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40a:11-23c.(2), a provision of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, Notice of Revisions or Addenda to Advertisements or Contract Documents shall be provided by the Township no later than seven (7) days, Saturdays, Sundays, or Holidays excepted, prior to the date for acceptance of bids, to any person who has submitted a bid or who has received a bid package in any of the following ways:*

- (i) *In writing by certified mail, or*
- (ii) *By certified facsimile transmission, meaning that the sender's (Architect's) facsimile machine produces a receipt showing date, and time of transmission and that the transmission was successful, or*
- (iii) *By a delivery service that provides certification of delivery to the sender*

*However, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23, a provision of the New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law, failure to obtain a receipt when good faith notice is sent or delivered to the address or telephone facsimile number on file with the Township shall not be considered failure by the Township to provide notice. Any addenda so issued shall become part of the Contract Documents. Failure of any bidder to receive such addenda shall not relieve the bidder from any requirements thereunder. The Township will not be responsible for any other explanations or interpretations of the Contract Documents which anyone may presume to make on behalf of the Township.*

2. The date for the pre-bid conference contained in IB 4 shall be October 23, 2013.
