NEW & OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Bloom noted that the Township requested proposals from various neighboring municipalities for court services, and proposals were due today. One proposal was received from Rockaway Township. The merits of the proposal were discussed. Rockaway's proposal is for \$75,000, as opposed to the current contract with Dover at \$90,000; both contracts incorporate annual 2% increases. Mr. Morris noted that the judge is the

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same in both Rockaway and Dover. Rockaway's proposal is for a shared court, as opposed to our current joint court with Dover; shared courts do not intermingle funds, which will likely prove advantageous.

Mr. Bucco expressed concerns with continuing the discussion in open session, and it was concluded that the discussion would be added to the closed session agenda.
