Individuals at increased risk for skin cancer are most likely to benefit from screening. Risk factors for skin cancer include

- family history of melanoma (two or more blood relatives)
- multiple atypical moles
- numerous actinic keratoses (scaly patches of skin, gray to pink in color, on sun-exposed areas of the body)
